Our Tour Guide will introduce you to the history of Carlisle Lugavallium, the Stanegate and the Wall Fort Uxellodunum as you leave the city. We will then show you many of the best views along the route of Hadrian's Wall World Heritage Site. There will be a stop at Lanercost Priory. We then follow the route via Banks Turret to view the Wall remains at Birdoswald Fort where you will have the option to walk a stretch of Hadrian's Wall Path to Gilsland. The guided tour then follows the Wall route into Northumberland National Park showing you remains of the Vallum at Cawfields and finally an option to visit the Fort and Museum at Vindolanda or to climb up to explore Housesteads Fort where you can enjoy some really fantastic views from the Whin Sill.
