



# Hedley Centre Accommodation Information for the 2018 season

---



## Bedrooms

All bedrooms in the Hedley Centre are set up as Single rooms with en-suite bathrooms with the exception of 1 twin / double room and two bedrooms in the annex share a shower room. We have provided each person with a set of towels and bedding.



## Safes

Safes are located in each room so that you have somewhere to keep your valuables during your stay. There is one safe per person in each room, Instructions for use are located on front of safes.

## Meals

During your stay, you will be catered on full board basis, with breakfast, packed lunch and a 3 course evening meal provided. Our Cook is able to cater for special dietary requirements therefore please confirm these within the booking form.

A cooked or continental breakfast will be served in the dining room between 8.00 a.m. and 08.30 a.m.

You will be provided with a packed lunch for each day of your excavation, this can be collected from the common room after breakfast each morning. Daily with the exception of Friday and Saturday your three course evening meal will be served in the dining room at 6.00 p.m. We will provide a voucher for use on the Saturday in either Vindolanda or Roman Army museum Cafés.

Dinner will not be served in the Hedley Centre on the Friday or Saturday evening, giving you the opportunity to enjoy an evening meal in one of the local pubs. There are also a number of takeaway shops in the area, if you would prefer. If you do choose to have a takeaway on Saturday evening, we would ask that you use the microwave and dining table. Please remove any rubbish and place in the bin provided.

### Communal area

There is an open plan lounge and dining area with comfortable seating, a large flat screen TV with FreeSat and a dining table where breakfast and evening meals will be served. Some Books and board games are also provided for residents to keep entertained in the evening.

### Parking

If you wish to bring a car with you, a secure gated car park is located directly behind the Hedley Centre.

### Boot room

There is a heated boot room located at the southern end of the building, this is for residents to leave boots and waterproofs to dry out ready for the next day's excavation.

### Kitchen

Access to the Kitchen is restricted to staff of the Hedley Centre, no residents are allowed to use Kitchen unless authorised by a member of Staff. A microwave is provided in the common room for residents use if required during periods when the housekeeper is not on duty.



#### Key Cards / FOBS

Access to the building and each bedroom is by use of key cards, Cards are programmed to access each area and also when placed in the energy saving consoles in each bedroom provide lighting and power to electrical sockets.

#### Laundry facilities

A laundry room with a washing machine, tumble drier and ironing facilities is available for use by excavation volunteers who are staying in the Hedley Centre. The laundry room can be accessed through the boot room.

#### Free Internet Access

The Centre is fitted with a secure Wi-Fi network and a number of wired connection points throughout the building. A password and access code will be issued to you on arrival for use during your stay.

#### Payphone

Due to poor mobile reception, a payphone is located in the common room for use of residents.

#### Cost

A 12 night stay costs £1100 *per person* including excavation fees. All excavation volunteers are required to be members of the Friends of Vindolanda membership scheme.

The Shared Room costs £1800 (£900 per person) This is booked by one person who give details of their room partner at time of booking.
